**PROFORMA FOR EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE FOR PwBD CANDIDATES SHORTLISTED FOR  
COMPUTER BASED TYPING SKILL TEST (CBTST)**

1. The 2nd Stage Computer Based Test (CBT-2) for Levels 5,3 and 2 was held from 12th June,2022 to 17th June, 2022. The results for Pay Levels 5 and 2 were published on 18th July, 2022. The CBTST for shortlisted candidates of Pay Levels 5 and 2 is tentatively scheduled from 12-08-2022, subject to the prevailing conditions.
2. In terms of para 13.4 of CEN 01/2019 the shortlisted PwBD candidates, who are permanently disabled due to Blindness/Low vision, Cerebral Palsy and Locomotor Disability with not less than 40% permanent disability may be exempted for CBTST, provided they upload a scanned copy of Typing Skill Test exemption certificate issued by the Competent Medical Board (constituted by Central or State Government) in the format prescribed in **Annexure V(E)** .
3. As already advised in the CBT-2 results dt:18.07.2022, the link for uploading of scanned copy of Typing Skill Test exemption certificate issued by the Competent Medical Board will be provided in the website of respective RRBs. The link will be available from 25.07.2022 to 28.07.2022 (upto 18.00hrs). The proforma of Typing Skill Test exemption certificate is enclosed and also available as **Annexure V(E)** of CEN01/2019.
4. The shortlisted PwBD candidates who seek exemption of CBTST should upload the scanned copy of Typing Skill Test exemption certificate issued by Competent Medical Board before the stipulated time. The candidates may view the status of their exemption for CBTST by 01.08.2022 on the same link.
5. Those candidates unable to upload the certificates, may report at the allotted CBTST venue along with the Original Typing Skill Test exemption certificate for seeking exemption.
6. The candidates are required to produce the same Typing Skill Test exemption certificate in Original during Document Verification, failing which his/her candidature will be summarily rejected.
7. Candidates are advised to refer only to the official websites of RRBs for latest updates on the recruitment process. Please do not be misled by unauthenticated sources.
8. Beware of touts who try to misguide candidates with fake promises of appointment for jobs on illegal consideration. RRB selections are based on Computer Based Test (CBT) and recruitment is based only on the merit of the candidates.

Note : (i) According to the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full participation) Rules, 1996 notified on 31.12.1996 by the Central Government in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-Section (1) and (2) of Section 73 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (1 of 1996), authorities to give disability Certificate will be a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or the State Government. The State Government may constitute a Medical Board consisting of at least three members out of which at least one shall be a specialist in the particular field for assessing locomotor / hearing and speech. (ii) The certificate would be valid for a period of 5 years for those whose disability is temporary. For those who acquired permanent disability, the validity can be shown as 'permanent'.
